

# On the Occurrence of Some Running Crab Spiders (Araneae: Philodromidae) in Turkey

**Abstract:** New findings of the running crab spiders (Philodromidae) from Turkey are given. Four species are identified, two of which (*Philodromus emarginatus* (SCHRANK, 1803) and *Thanatus fabricii* (AUDOUIN, 1826)) are new for the fauna of Turkey; two (*Thanatus imbecillus* L. Koch, 1878 and *T. oblongiusculus* (LUCAS, 1846)) have been shown to have much wider distributions in the country.
